

# A CHINESE PUZZLE

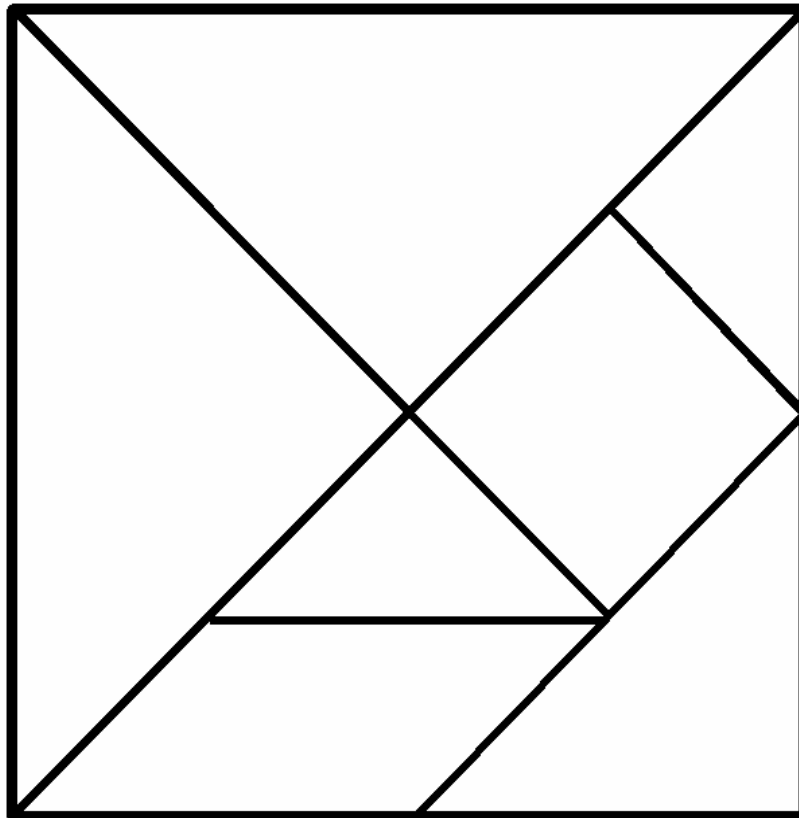
## Tangrams

**Cut out the pieces from the Tangram square below.**

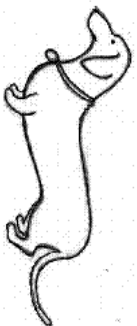
**Then try and solve some of the Tangram puzzles on the next pages.**



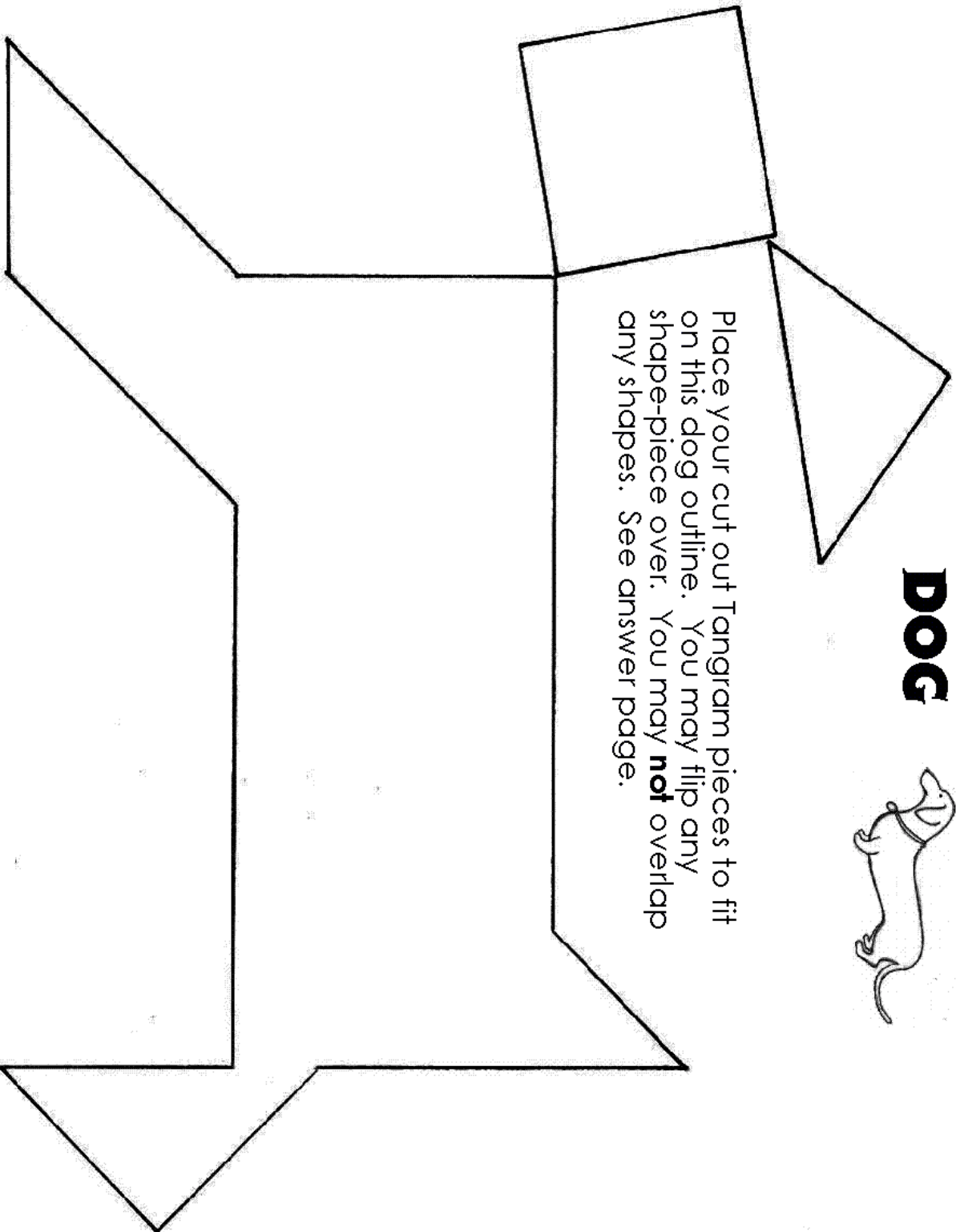

**DOG**



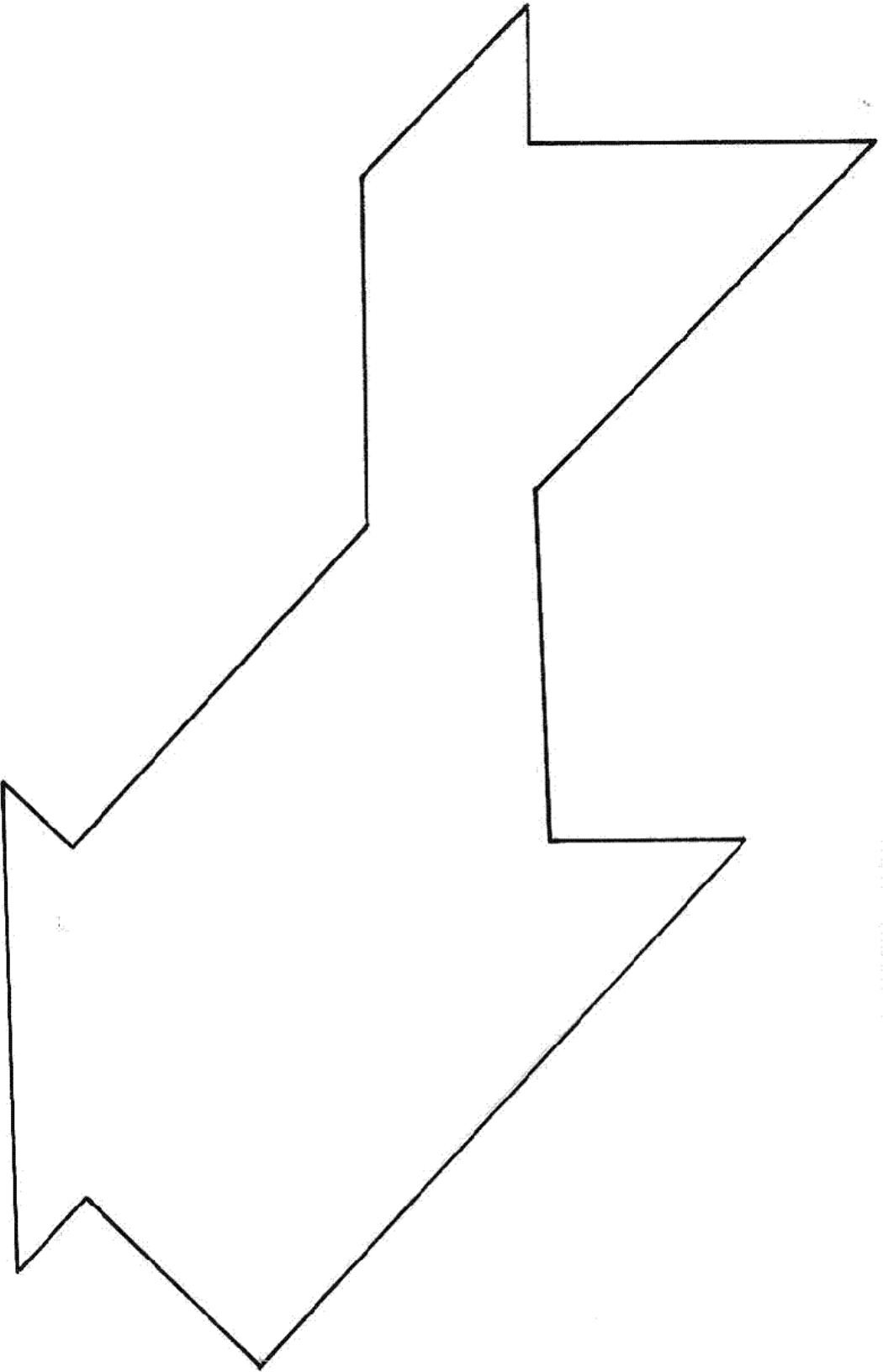
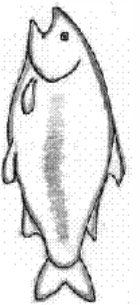
Place your cut out Tangram pieces to fit on this dog outline. You may flip any shape-piece over. You may **not** overlap any shapes. See answer page.
