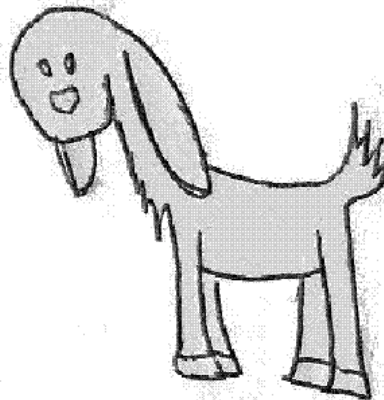
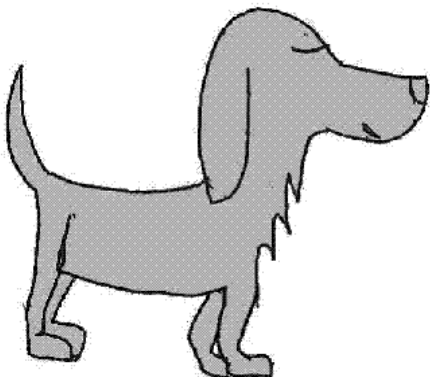

SHORT VOWEL SOUNDS

► **Note to tutor:** Beginning readers often struggle with remembering short vowel sounds. Short vowel sounds can be more difficult to remember than consonant sounds. It sometimes helps kids to memorize a **key-word** for each vowel sound. If your student has not already learned key-words for short vowel sounds in school, you can teach the following. You can cut out and use the flash cards on the following page, if you want.

a: apple 

e: elephant 

i: igloo 

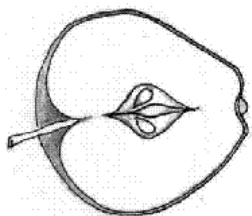
o: octopus

Use these flash-cards if you haven't already learned other vowel key-words at school.

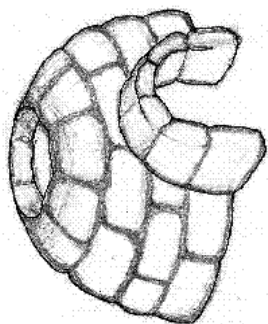
CUT along solid lines. **FOLD** along dotted lines to make flashcards.



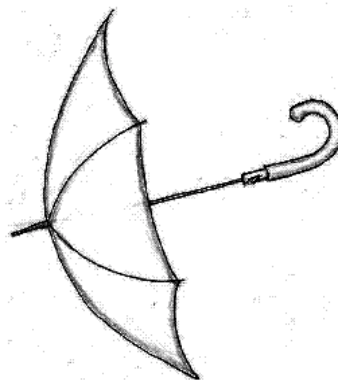

Spit: (begging) Reff, reff ...

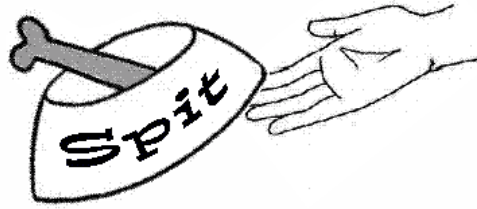
Spot: (...and madder) Riff, reff,

ruff, ruff !!!!!

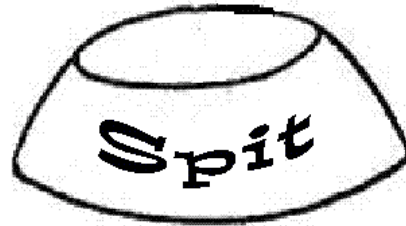
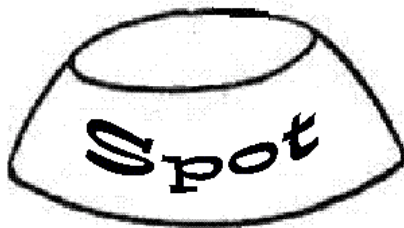


Spit: ...(happy) Ruff!

drep, drebble.**

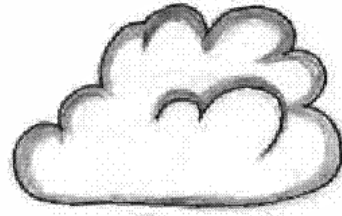
Umbrella: lck, iggle

drebble, drabble, drobble.**

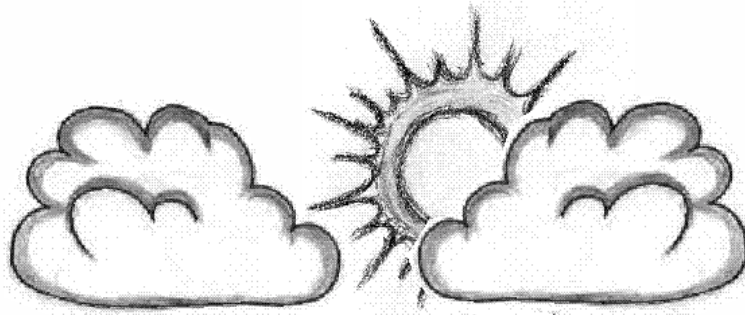
Umbrella: grimble, grumble

Rain: Drubble, dribble, drip

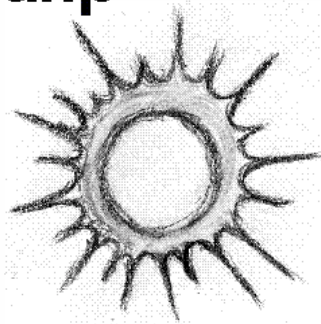
Umbrella: (hopeful) Yip?
