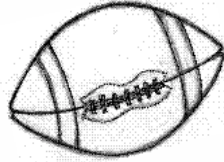
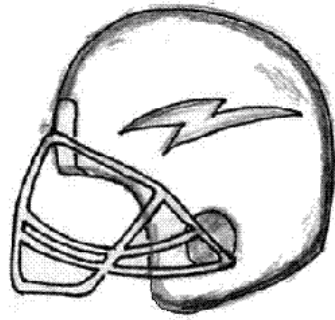


FOOTBALL SPELLING



If you are like most kids you have a spelling test this Friday. Here is a way to study for that Friday test that feels more like playing a game than studying for a test.

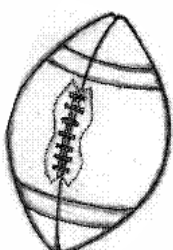


Write one quarter of your spelling words in each quarter section of the football field. Give the paper to a friend, so you can't see the words. Your friend will start with the quarter section farthest to the left, and ask you to spell the words in that first section. If you can spell the words in that section correctly in no more than 2 tries, you make a **first down** and you can proceed to the next quadrant of spelling words. If you can't spell all the words in a section correctly in 2 tries, you have to go back to the beginning and start all over. Once you spell successfully through all four sections you score a touchdown!

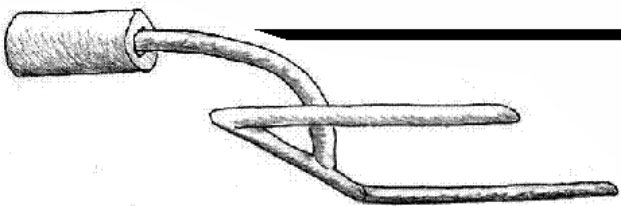

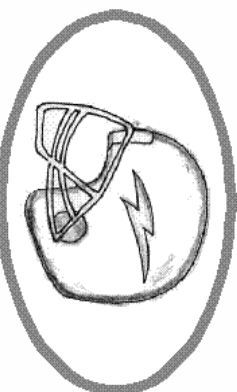

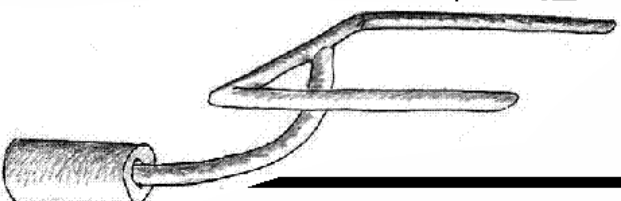
