

# LEARN HOW TO SPELL "SCHUYLKILL" WITH THE SPELLING MACHINES

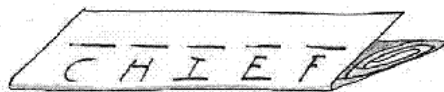
If you live in Philadelphia, you've heard of the "Schuylkill River, the Schuylkill Expressway. But even adults don't know how to spell the word "Schuylkill". Once you learn how to spell it challenge some adults to a spelling bee.

Here's two ways to help you practice spelling "Schuylkill" correctly.

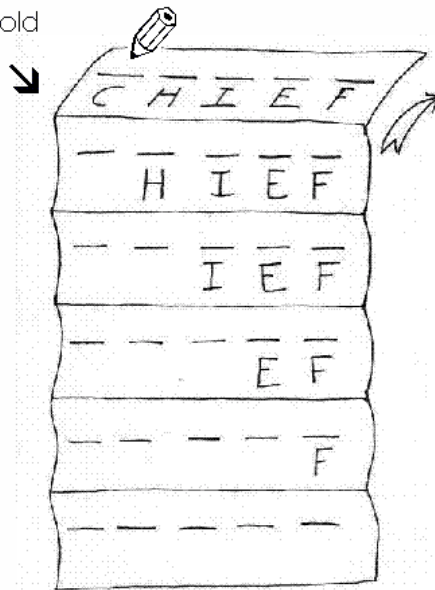
You can use these systems for other tough spelling words. The examples shows you how to spell the word "Chief".

## SPELLING MACHINE # ONE: (see next page)

1. Fold along the lines so your paper looks like this:



2. Fold



3. Copy each letter onto the blank above it.

4. Fold back the section you just filled in so that you can no longer see it.

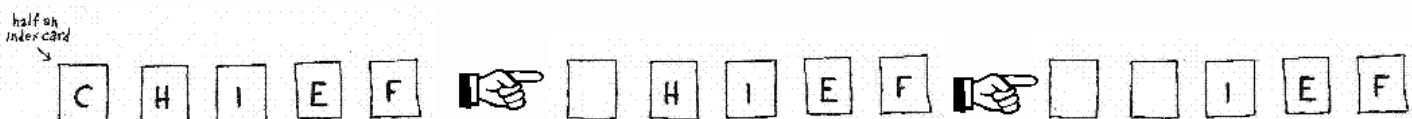
5. Write the letters in the blanks again on the new section. This time you won't see what the first letter is.

6. Continue. Each time, fold back the section you just finished so that you can't see it. As you go from section to section you'll need to remember more and more letters on your own.

**Fill in the last section correctly ... and you know how to spell the word!**

## SPELLING MACHINE # TWO:

Cut index cards in half, one half section for each letter in your word. Write one letter on each half card. Lay out the half cards in the order that spells the word. With all the cards face up, spell the word out loud, looking at the cards. Then turnover the first card, spell the word again, without having the first letter to help you. Keep on flipping over the cards until you can spell the whole word without help.



... and so on until all cards are turned over.
