

# CRAFT:

## Rolled Paper beads

**Step One:** Cut out a triangle from the most colorful part of a colorful page of a magazine. The triangles can be around an inch wide at the base. They can be as long as the width of the page (8 inches or so).

**Supplies:** Old magazines, pencils, scissors, craft glue, string  
(extra: newspaper, acrylic spray)

**Ages:** third grade and up

**Step Two:** Starting with the wide end of the triangle, roll it around a pencil. Continue rolling until you reach the point of the triangle. Glue the point down with a dot of glue. Slide the paper bead off the pencil. Make as many beads as you want.

**Step Three:** String these beads on a cord. Yarn, dental floss, white string work well. Make a necklace, or a bracelet, or a key-chain, or a light-pull, ...or...

**Extra:** To give your beads a shiny look you can spray some acrylic sealer or varnish after you've finished stringing the beads. Be sure to get an adult's help for this.
