Cut out the cards. Put the five smaller single letter cards on top of the **base card**. Staple these single letter cards on the far left side of the base card. Then flip the single letter cards and read each word. The cards on this page make 2 separate flip books. These flip books correspond with the words used in the story-script "**Animal Language Academy**".

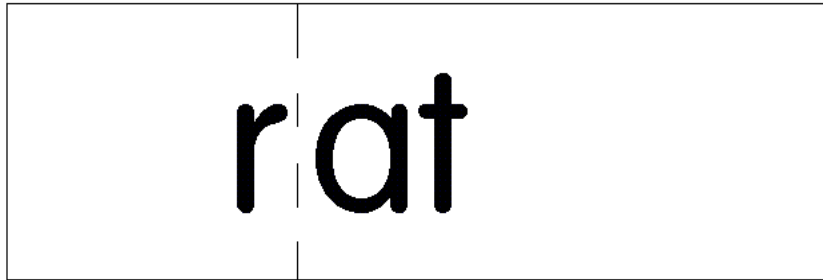

Note: Some of these words will be nonsense words - have fun making up meanings for them if you want: example:

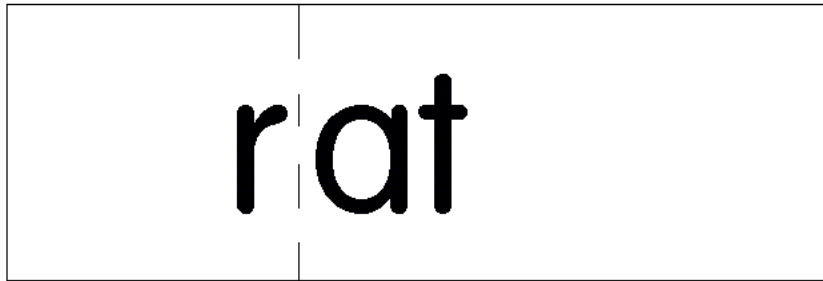
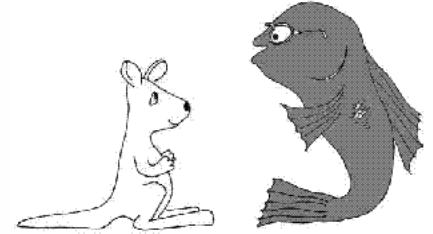
Bap: a scary fish-headed monster that lives in the North Pole.
