

Ugly Monster Game (Old Maid)



Cut out the cards on the next two pages. Have a student draw an ugly monster on the blank card. Deal out all the cards evenly between all the players. The players first find any matches they might have been dealt. They read these matches out loud and set them aside. The players then hold their cards fanned out with the card faces hidden from the other players. The first player takes a card from the hand of any other player. If a match is made, then the player reads the match, sets the match aside and takes another turn. If no match is made the player adds the new card to his hand and the play continues with the next player. After all the possible matches are made, the player left with the "ugly monster" loses. The words in this game corresponds with the story-script 'The Story of Jairus and his Child'.
