 The **Scholastic Homework Reference Series** (written by Anne Zenman and Kate Kelly, 1995 Scholastic, Inc.) is an excellent reference for homework help. The books in this series are attractive, with very clear explanations. They do a good job of covering the basics. Everything You Need to Know about Math Homework is particularly helpful.
