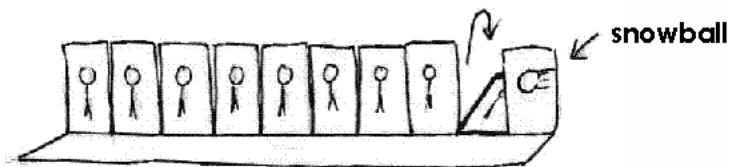


# SOMETHING TO HELP YOU GET THROUGH A LONG LIST OF HOMEWORK PROBLEMS

After a long day of school, sometimes it is hard to concentrate on a page full of homework problems. This might help. Cut out and set-up the figures below as shown. A snow ball is heading for the guy, as you finish the first homework problem fold down the first guy. Good! he's ducked the snowball! Now finish the second problem to save the second guy and so forth. This will get you through ten problems. Start the snowball ducking over if you have more than ten problems. This game will help you see how many problems you have and visualize your progress...that could help get you through! (It also helps if you can get a tutor to cheer you on as you help the guy duck the snowballs).



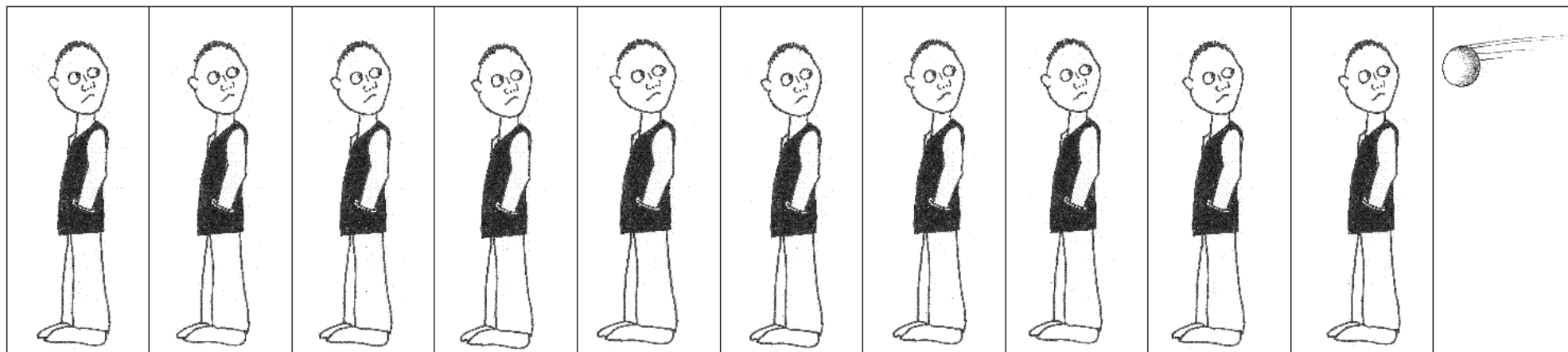
Fold down one guy for each problem you finish. When the guy is folded down he's ducked the snowball.
