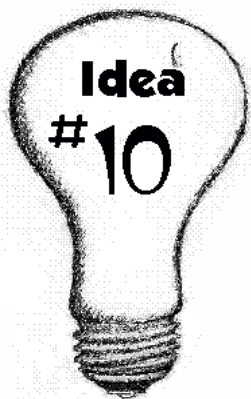

A Chinese Puzzle

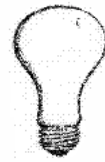
Tangrams is an ancient puzzle from China. With just seven geometric pieces cut from a square, you and your child can create and solve many, many puzzles with each other.



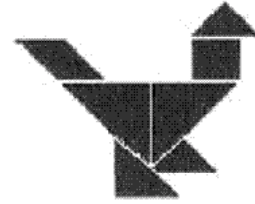

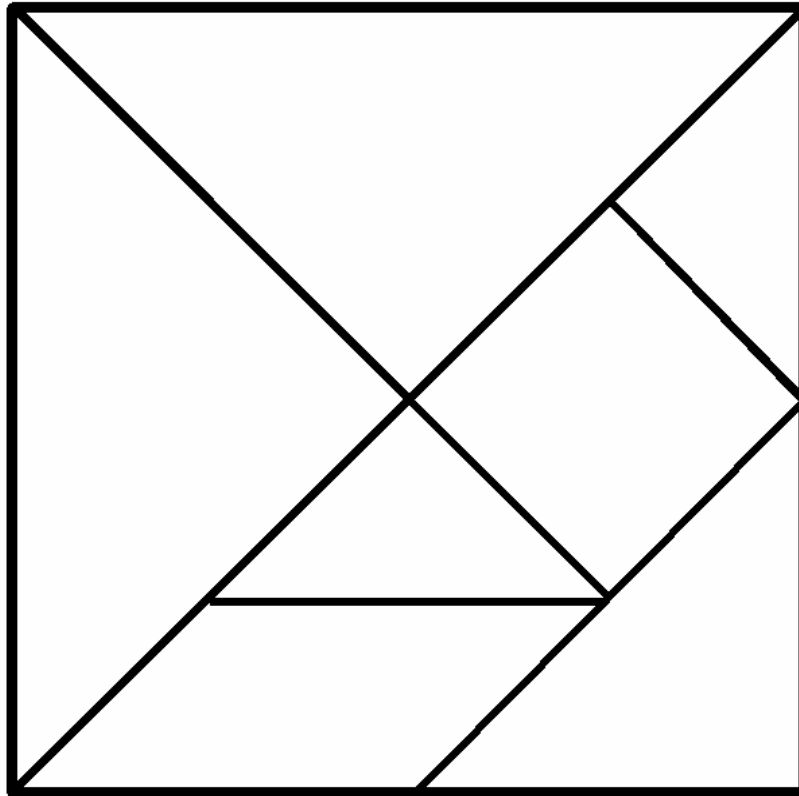

Cut out the pieces from the Tangram square below.

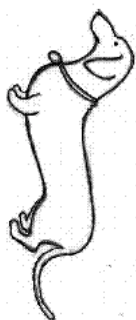

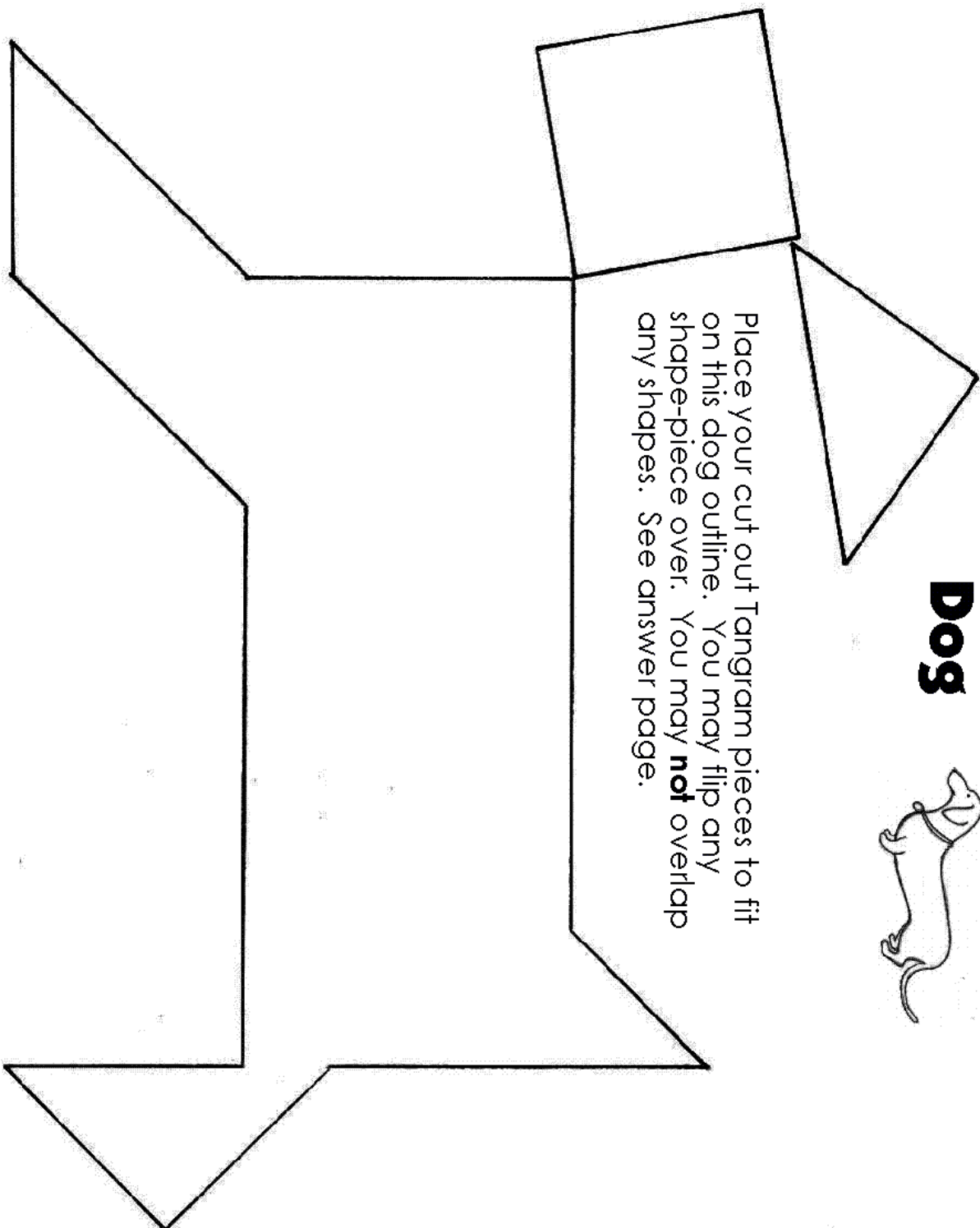

Dog



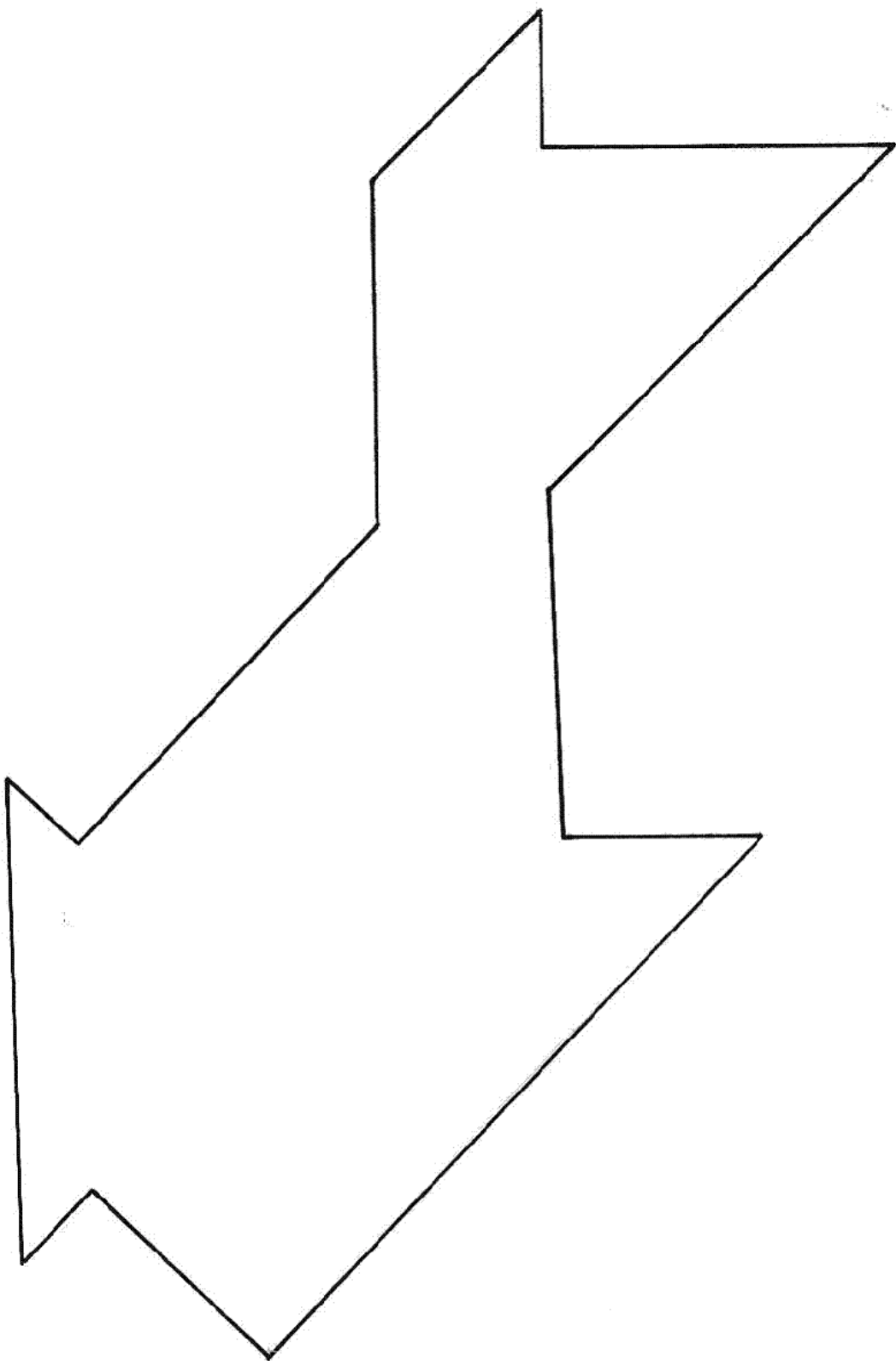
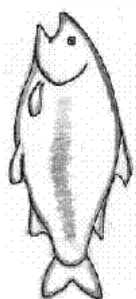
Place your cut out Tangram pieces to fit on this dog outline. You may flip any shape-piece over. You may **not** overlap any shapes. See answer page.
