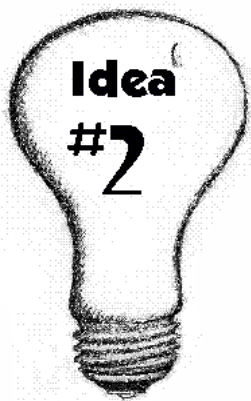


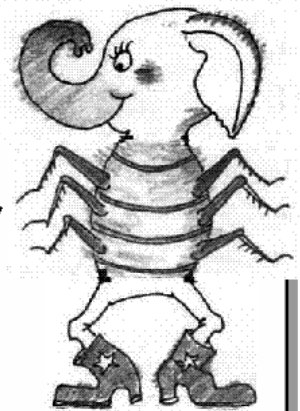

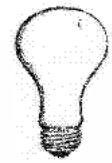
Make a Monster Together

You can Make a Monster

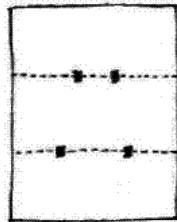

Idea #2

It is fun and easy to make a **monster** together. You won't know what it looks like until you are all done.

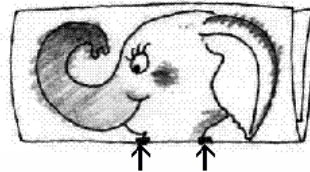
#1 Use a sheet of paper like the one given on the next page.



#2 Fold the page into thirds, like this:

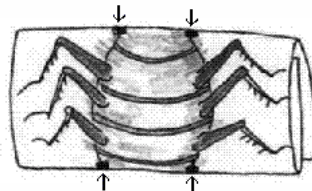


#3 WITHOUT LETTING YOUR PARTNER SEE, draw a head of a creature on the top folded panel. Have the neck of this head end on the two black guide squares.

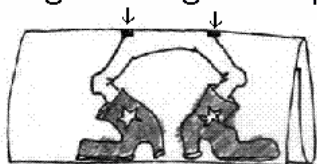


guide squares

#4 Turn your drawing face-down so that your partner can't see what you drew, and pass the empty middle panel to your partner. Your partner will then draw a torso. The torso will start on the guide squares on top of the panel so that it will match up to the head you drew. The torso will end at the guide squares at the bottom of the panel. Your partner will not let you see what he/she is drawing.



#5 After your partner has drawn the torso, he/she will fold out the last panel for you to draw the monster's legs. Your partner will be very careful not to peek at the head you have already drawn. You will draw the legs, starting at the guide squares on the top of the panel.



When you are finished drawing the legs ... you are ready for the

unveiling!!

TIP: make two monsters on two different sheets of paper at the same time, so you don't have to wait for each other while you draw.
