an **UNMAGNIFYING** glass:

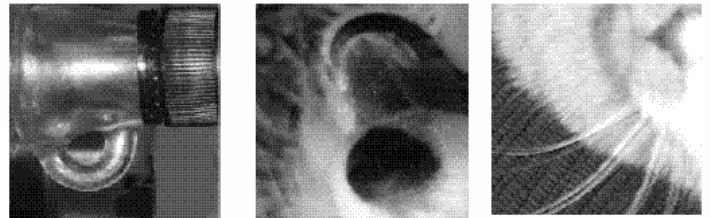
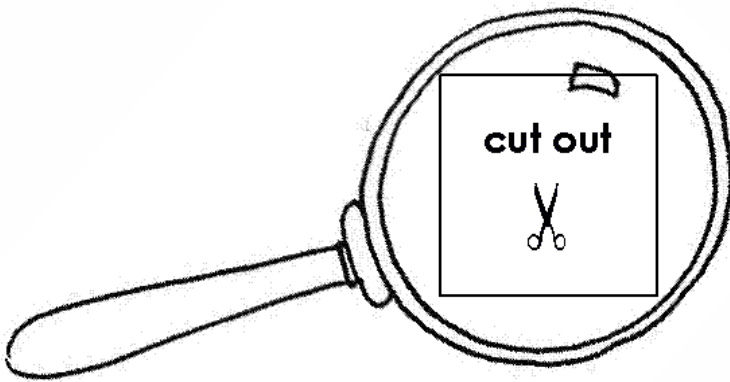
How MRS. KNOW-IT-ALL KNOWS it all

THE UNMAGNIFYING GLASS.

To make an **unmagnifying glass** just cut out the one inch square on this or another piece of paper. Put this square window over something you want to observe and look at it closely. **Take your time.** How much can you notice this close up that you've not noticed before?



SOME CLOSE UPS: WHAT ARE THEY?? (THEY MIGHT BE SIDEWAYS OR UPSIDE-DOWN)

ANSWERS: syrup bottle-top dog-nose cat-whiskers

THE MAGNIFYING GLASS.

You can make a simple **magnifying glass** by simply putting a tablespoon of water onto some clear plastic wrap. Hold this over things you want to observe. The things will be slightly magnified.
