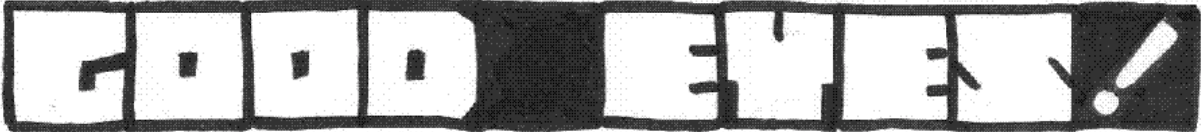
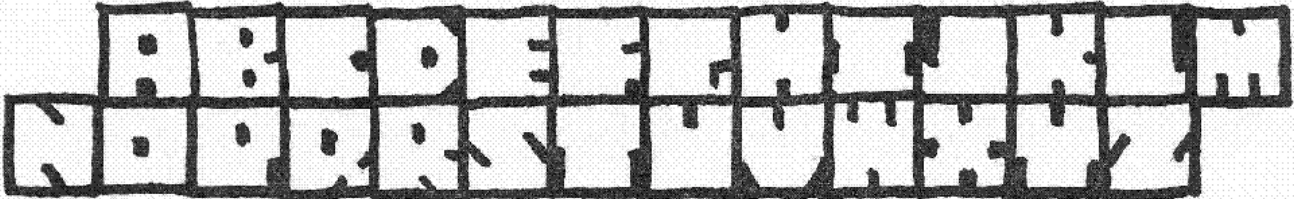


INSIDE OUT WRITING

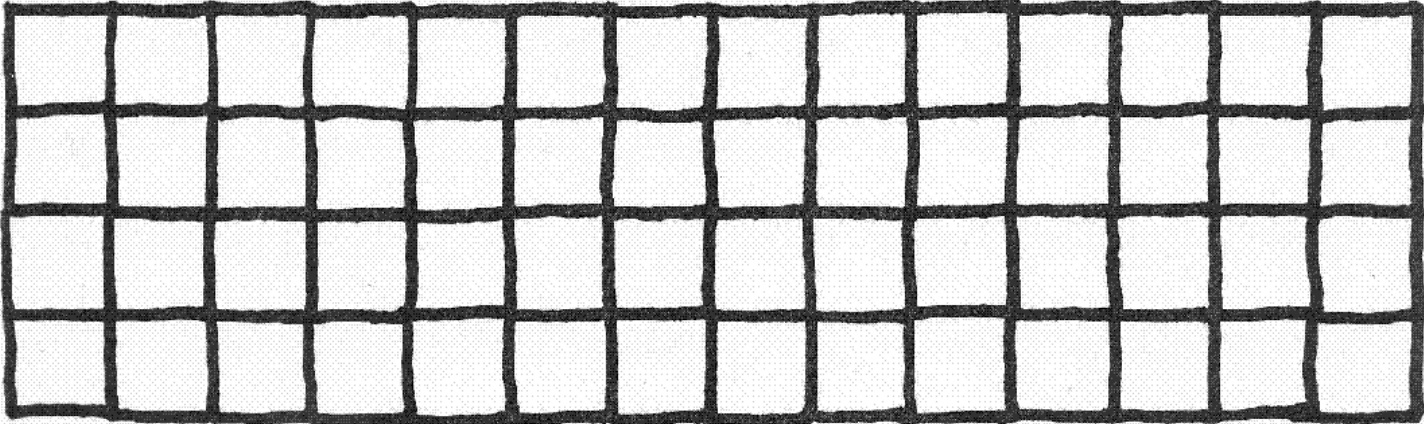

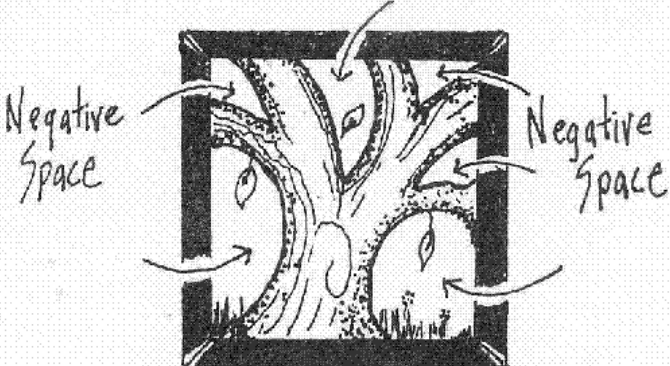
THE "INSIDE-OUT" ALPHABET:



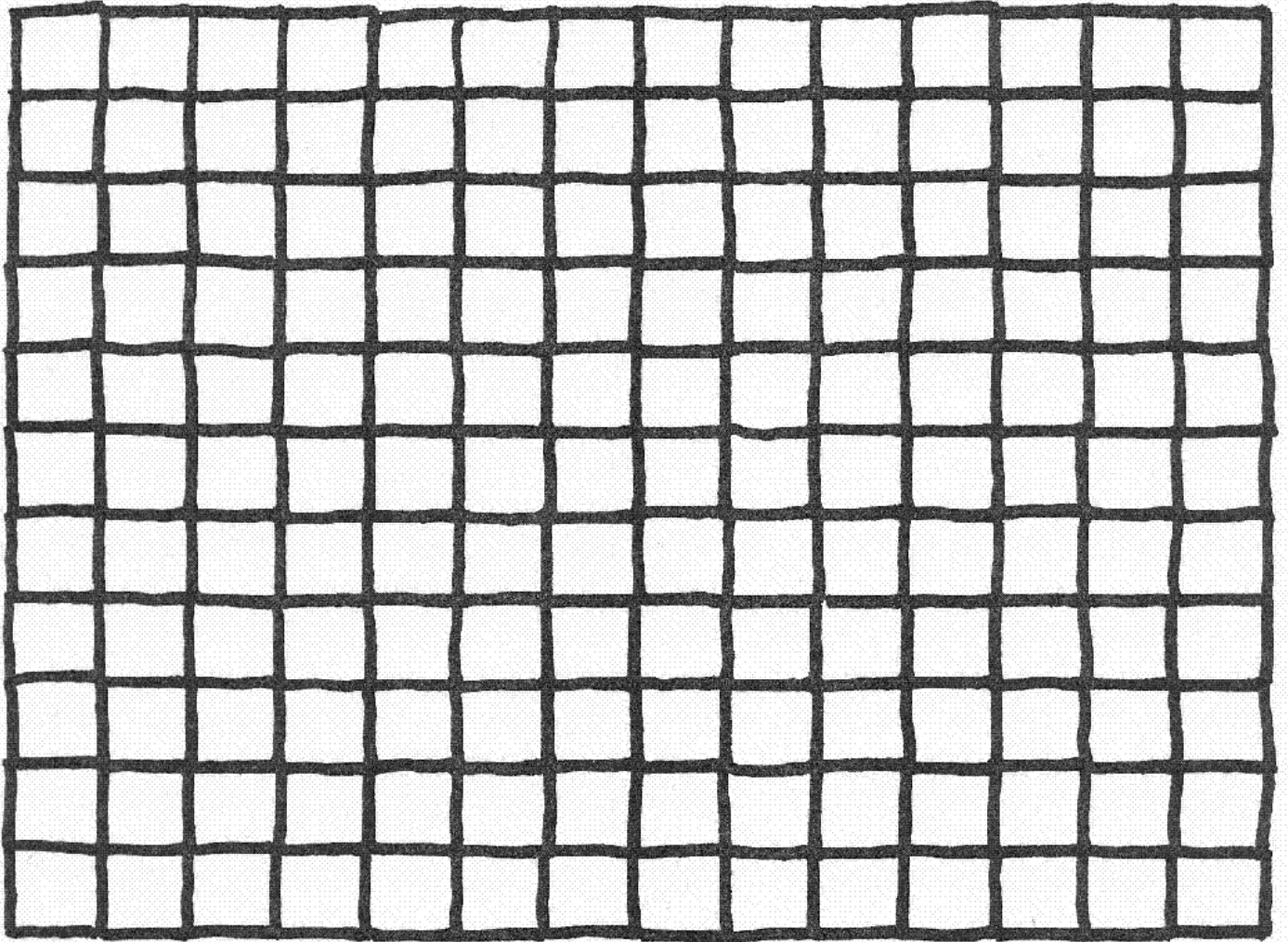
NOW you try writing something "inside out". You can start with your name:



NEGATIVE SPACE: Artists use the term "negative space" to mean the space that fills in around and between the objects in a painting. People don't usually pay very much attention to negative space because they are concentrating on the forms and figures in the artwork, not on the space between the shapes. This "inside-out" writing does the same thing. The reason you might not have been able to read the writing right away is that you were concentrating on the black lines in the boxes, not on the space around them. This kind of writing could be called **"Negative Space Writing"**
